was to be permissive or mandatory rather than the Legislature would have to create the structure of regions before any counties could be established.

THE CHAIRMAN: I am not so sure that the distinction you are drawing is one that is at all clear. It is not clear to me. Part of my difficulty stems from the fact that as I indicated originally, I had great difficulty and still have great difficulty in separating in my mind the permissive vote from this question.

It seems to me that the two are inherently tied together. But I think if we get a vote on this question as to who can call into being the regional government, that maybe we can unwavel the tangle that I think we may be in. Judge Adkins.

JUDGE ADKINS: May I ask if we are now considering the right to call into being or to origination by petition so to speak and also the right of local county units to call, raise, or create a regional government? What I am trying to ask, I guess, is, are we talking about two other ways or just one other way?
