Legislature if it acts in the area of creating regions may create regions and create a form of government for the region or it may provide that the form of government for the region shall be determined by the participating governments or by members of a charter board and adoption of a charter and so forth. If the intent of the Commission is that when the Legislature acts to create regions and to create regional governments, it must do so by means of affording to the local areas and the local governments the right to draft the charter.

Then I take it that would satisfy at least some. The opposite view would be that the Legislature and only the Legislature could draft and provide the form of government. There is a third alternative that you could conceive of, I suppose, and that is that the Legislature would provide the initial form of government which, could then be amended by the people or the supporting governments. Dr. Jenkins.

DR. JENKINS: I think I am in favor of a procedure -- we have voted to make this permissive and
