it.

DR. BARD: I voted earlier in letting the people have the choice in the first place and if they can't and if it operates like ll(a), which indicates right now in terms of formation of home rule, the General Assembly at its first session after the adoption of the amendment shall by public general law apply the grant of expressed powers.

Once this grant of expressed powers is stated, then there are different ways of operating after that point. Now I firmly believe that had it not been for the voice of the peopl. in Anne Arundel County, they wouldn't have home rule now.

So the very least that I would like to see happen is once the General Assembly takes the first lead.—in fact, I would like to have the people have the opportunity of first leave as well but we voted that down in the last motion, then I would say the people ought to have the right to follow in connection with the specific nature of that region.
