THE CHAIRMAN: Yes, you could because I think that if the, with the majority of the Commission, if they favor giving the right to the local groups to determine the form of government of the region, in my mind it is inconsistent with the previous vote which is another way of saying that I probably misunderstood the previous vote.

MR. MARTINEAU: Could I explain the previous vote? I think the Committee can be understood by looking at the staff memo draft 11.02(a). If you look at the first words, the state shall be divided into so many regions by law, what we have now said is that the state may be divided into so many regions by law. Now that we voted on. Now we are voting on the second part of that which says for which regional representative governments may be established in accordance with law by the General Assembly by concurrent action of the counties legislative body or affirmative action.
