inconceivable to me that the Legislature is going to 1 pass a law creating regions and not doing any more than that. MR. MARTINEAU: They can. 5 THE CHAIRMAN: The question can be resolved by the vote here. 6 7 MR. SYKES: I have a question of whether or not no matter how we vote on this it would still be open 8 to the Legislature to change the regions around after the 9 citizens within a given region try to establish a regional 10 government so as to render what the citizens have 11 12 done ineffective. 13 It doesn't make any difference which way 14 we vote. 15 MR. CLAGETT: That is exactly right. 16 MR. MARTINEAU: And the Legislature can take away all the powers. 17 18 MR, BROOKS: That is a separate question. 19 THE CHAIRMAN: We are not making progress. Let's take a vote and then go to lunch. 20 21 The question arises on whether or not
