involved and to me that means that if the regional government is established or a form of regional government provided by act of the Legislature, the act of the Legislature must either submit that to a referendum or provide that it is subject to change by the action of the local governments or the people of the area.

If there is a different interpretation of the combination of the two votes, I don't know, understand what it is. Does anybody have any different interpretation? Mr. Sykes.

MR. SYKES: I was with the Chairman up until the last point but I understand that the vote means in effect that the ultimate control is in the Legislature, that the people can, if they want to create a regional government and within a region but it must be within the region determined by the Legislature and the -- if the people start it, the Legislature can change the region and render the vote --

THE CHAIRMAN: You are talking about the region rather than the regional government?

MR. SYKES: That is right. I understood the
