to the present Constitution where there is provision for home rule and county rule but which is optional with the people to initiate? I look upon what the Legislature might end up doing as precisely the same kind of thing.

MR. CLAGETT: I have a question of Dr. Winslow. Assuming for the moment that the General Assembly created a region composed of, let us say, two counties. And then assuming that a structure, however it came about, for the operation of that government came into existence and the General Assembly later passed a law saying that there should be no bb guns in that region -- wouldn't that run afoul of our restriction upon the General Assembly to pass local laws?

DR. WINSLOW: No, no.

MR. CLAGETT: It would only affect two counties, the region.

DR. WINSLOW: But this would be under your general rule for classification.

MR. CIAGETT: No, that is the next question.
