The home rules amendment would apply to counties only, the Legislature could effectively govern by its power over regions. It could do the same kind of thing with intergovernmental authorities. It could set the salaries of officers and say how many clerks could be employed and, as I read this draft now, I hope to be corrected if I am wrong, there is no restriction whatever upon the Legislature so long as it governs locally through authorities and regions rather than through counties.

THE CHAIRMAN: Mrs. Freedlander.

MRS. FREEDLANDER: That is precisely why we wanted to have the powers these regions would have would be only the powers which the counties gave them in a joint, tri-joint resolution or action.

MR. SYKES: I don't know what the recommendation is but I would like to know if I am correct in my reading of the draft.

MR. CLAGETT: I think the answer is that if it attempted to do so, it could create these intergovernmental authorities. It could create the regions
