resolved all the problems in connection with regional 1 2 governments or how we are going to create them. I think we have resolved all we can resolve right now unless we just drop everything else and concentrate on this which we simply can't do. I am therefore going to 5 suggest that we move to Section 11.02 and the other sections keeping away except to highlight problems arising out of the regional government concept to see if we 8 can at least get the rest of it in reasonably good 10 condition, and I think in a half hour we will simply 11 have to suspend this discussion and move to consideration 12

of the other matters and then if we can conclude the other matters, come back to this.

But otherwise, there are very urgent matters we must act on this afternoon that we will not reach.

Can we do that. Mr. Clagett?

. MR. CLAGETT: Yes, Mr. Chairman, and I am now directing your attention to Page 13 of the Committee's Sixth Report and there we begin with Section 11.02, powers of counties and other civil divisions, Subsection (a), a county may exercise any power or perform any
