to go through two. The General Assembly makes a determination. It makes a determination which is implicit when it writes its bill.

MR. BROOKS: That is what I read in here.

MR. SYKES: And the words by law provide whatever protection has to be provided because the final product is subject to scrutiny and doesn't make any difference whether the basis as such is reviewable or nonreviewable.

MR. BROOKS: That's right. We don't disagree.

MR. SYKES: You can't separate the two of them in any meaningful way. So I suggest the question poses, the section poses no policy question.

THE CHAIRMAN: Wouldn't the proper language be classes of counties based upon population as determined by the most recent United States Census or upon other criteria as may be provided by law?

MRS. FREEDLANDER: Yes.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any objection to that change? Strike out the parenthesis, strike out such and strike out as are determined by the General Assembly to be
