local governing authority but it doesn't follow from the definition. For instance, the Legislature heretofore has enacted every year local laws for the county and the city.

MR. MARTINFAU: That is correct, but we are saying here that the Legislature can only enact public local laws.

THE CHAIRMAN: We intend to say that but my point is I don't think we have said it.

MR. SYKES: I am not sure we intend to say that because that is what raises the question of the interconnection between C and D. The Legislature may legislate for intergovernmental authority and it may legislate applicable to a regional and it is conceivable that those lines may or may not be identical with the classification of counties and you have got to provide for some kind of relationship between the intergovernmental authorities and regions on the one hand and counties on the other if they are all to co-exist.

THE CHAIRMAN: Could you accommodate that notion by a phrase such as except as may be otherwise
