with just exactly what we have got here after we got through revising it at that time so that after the material was stricken, the provision read just as we have got it here.

Now let me read it as it was originally. The General Assembly may provide notwithstanding any other provisions of this article for the creation of intergovernmental authorities on its own initiative or on the request of one or more political subdivisions to administer single or multi-purpose functions or services which transcend local boundaries are not soluable through local cooperation.

And then it provides for the power to impose and collect revenues and taxes as imposed by the General Assembly about which we have no dispute. Now when you got through revising that language you came up with, and I ask you now to compare it with what you have in front of you, the General Assembly may provide for the creation of intergovernmental authorities to administer single or multi-purpose functions or services which transcend local boundaires, and there follows the rest
