MR. MARTINEAU: I submit that the language that we have here is the one that we are going to have to adop notwithstanding Mr. Sykes' fear because I frankly think your earlier language gave no protection whatsoever. If the Legislature found it was an insoluable problem, the court would be stuck with that finding and if they wanted to legislate. As Mr. Sykes fears, they will go ahead and do it.

answer because you have heretofore approved the provisions under which the Legislature has full power over counties, the creation and existence, dissolution, changes the county lines and full power over classification of counties. Having gone that far, it seems to me that you try to put a block on the power of the is Legislature with respect to regions/ getting yourself tied into knots and really don't accomplish anything.

MR. SYKES: I don't know whether it is right to do it but I am not suggesting any diminution of the Legislature's power to create or structure.
