assuming they have all those powers and I don't think that is a correct assumption.

MR. BOOKS: Oh, no, the assumption is the powers they don't have would be for the county to give them and those powers as given them by the county would be subject to withdrawal by the county without legislative or consent of the cities.

of the proposition as I understand it which I think would embrace Mr. Martineau's principle and not do violence to the one you have indicated. A county may provide by public local law for the creation of any new municipal corporation within its boundaries and for methods of incorporation, merging, dissolving and existing any new municipal corporations and altering their boundaries but no existing municipal corporation shall be dissolved or have any powers presently exercised by it withdrawn without its consent or the consent of the General Assembly by law.
