corporation for the joint administration for any of their functions and powers and the sharing of costs thereof.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any questions? Any comment? I think we will all agree with the comment we made when we started this. This is the most difficult of all the provisions we have to concern ourselves with. We have a number of matters that we simply must act on today. I don't want to treat any of them summarily.

I will try to take up each in the order of their urgency. I think the first matter I want to ask you to consider and make a decision about is the question of whether the Commission should or should not make a public statement or take a position with respect to the 16 constitutional amendments which would be on the ballot next month or any of them. I point out to you that this is not a question that is easy to resolve.

At first blush it is seemingly the answer to say well, it deals with a matter that we are working on and we should express our views. Another opposite view is that the Commission is preparing for a convention
