For instance, there are several that make special exception of certain counties that are nothing but special legislation that absolutely flout every thing that has been discussed here in the last 24 hours about special lesiglation. That in themselves would have to be considered an evil as far as the Constitution is concerned and that they exclude a particular county from being covered by a constitutional provision.

There are a number of different things where you might say there is another class of these amendments which really don't make any difference one way or the other what happens to them insofar as they probably would not affect the new draft because the type of material discussed would not be considered in a new Constitution.

DR. JENKINS: I think the Commission should remain silent on this question.

MR. SCANLAN: I agree with Dr. Jenkins. We remain silent when a more pressing and important issue is before the voters, namely, the referendum on the convention itself and we wisely stayed in the background and let an independent agency, an independent
