new Constitution after it had been adopted by this 1 group, but I very much doubt if we should turn ourselves 2 into an organization to espouse a cause as an organiza-3 tion, a Commission rather. 5 DR. JENKINS: Are you prepared to receive a motion? THE CHAIRMAN: Yes. Let me make this observation before you propose a motion. The only reason I 8 do it is because I might forget it. Mr. Martineau made 10 a comment that would bother me. I am afraid that if 11 we were to make a statement that some of these amendments 12 were consistent with what we were doing and some were 13 not and it really didn't make any difference to us because we are dealing with a document that might be 14 the kiss of death on all of them. 15 16 It might create a feeling of people, 17

well, there is no use bothering about that.

MR. MARTINEAU: I didn't mean that. Certainly we don't want to say that these matters shouldn't be voted on intelligently because the convention after all may not even adopt a new Constitution but I think we
