1	MR. HARGROVE: I will second.
2	MR. MARTINEAU: When is it proper to make
3	an amendment to that?
4	MR. GENTRY: That is what I want to make.
5	THE CHAIRMAN: Wait a second and let Mr.
6	Miller speak to his motion.
7	MR. MILLER: I really made my speech. I
8	think it is more simple not to have to look up in the
9	book every time you want to find out how many votes
10	are necessary and it is a difference between 10/15ths
11	and 9/15ths and I think we can well afford to make
12	them all the same whichever way the Commission wants.
13	THE CHAIRMAN: I will recognize to move the
14	amendment.
15	MR. GENTRY: I would like to move the
16	motion be amended to make it two-thirds vote for every-
17	thing across the board.
18	THE CHAIRMAN: You will accept the amendment,
19	Mr. Miller?
