2 THE CHAIRMAN: Who will second it?

3 MR. CLAGETT: I will second it.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: Then the motion now before  
5 you is to provide that all extraordinary votes be two-  
6 thirds. Mr. Martineau.

7 MR. MARTINEAU: I would like to draw a  
8 distinction between those votes which remove someone  
9 from office or has the effect of that; in other words,  
10 I believe that there should be a higher vote for  
11 declaring the governor unable to perform his duties,  
12 expelling a member.

13 THE CHAIRMAN: Higher than two-thirds.

14 MR. MARTINEAU: No, higher than the three-  
15 fifths.

16 THE CHAIRMAN: The motion is now two-thirds.

17 MR. HOFF: The motion is now two-thirds.

18 MR. MARTINEAU: Well, I want a compromise  
19 between the two. I want everything three-fifths  
20 except two-thirds for removing a person from office,  
21 impeaching, and so forth.
