thirds of the voters voting thereon. A vote aye is a vote in favor.

MR. MARTINFAU: Wait a minute.

MRS. BOTHE: I didn't understand the reference to constitutional amendments.

THE CHAIRMAN: I am sorry. I stated it quite incorrectly. It would be the same thing, two-thirds, proposing constitutional amendments, two-thirds of the elected members of each house for constitutional amendments as well as everthing else. A vote use is a vote in favor of a uniform two-thirds requirement. All in favor, please signify by a show of hands. Contrary? The motion is carried nine to seven.

MR. CLAGETT: School children will have less work.

MR. SCANLAN: And the Legislature will have less power. The way that came to a vote, there might have been some in favor of the principle of uniformity and others favor the principle of two-thirds that produced the small majority. I suppose it is impossible to go back again and see how many, is it too late to
