MR. MARTINEAU: I would like to amend that.

THE CHAIRMAN: The action was to be taken

on a previous motion. Mr. Martineau.

MR. MARTINEAU: I would like to move that the motion be amended that with respect to those votes declaring the Governor unable to carry out the duties, expelling a member of the House, and removing a person who has been impeached, that the vote be two-thirds.

MR. MITCHELL: I will second.

MR. SYKES: Can I make a suggestion? I would like to ask unanimous consent to suspend all rules and to cut the Gordian knot by asking the consent of the body to present two questions. First are we to have a uniform number and if it is agreed that we should have a uniform number, then take a vote, all those favoring three-fifths, all those favoring two-thirds. It seems to me otherwise we are going to be here a long time.

MR. JENKINS: I will second that if you add without debate.

MR. SYKES: Yes. We have had the debate.
