

1 THE CHAIRMAN: This takes us right back
2 to Mr. Miller's original motion. But what is your
3 pleasure?

4 MRS. BOTHE: Let's do it.

5 THE CHAIRMAN: Any objection?

6 MR. MILLER: Unanimous consent.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: The first question arises on
8 the question of whether the extraordinary vote
9 shall be uniform, that is, the same number required in
10 all cases. A vote aye is a vote in favor of uniformity
11 in all cases. A vote no is a vote against
12 uniformity. Are you ready for the question? All those
13 in favor of uniformity, please signify by a show of hands.
14 Those opposed. The motion carries, nine to eight.

15 MRS. BOTHE: I move that the vote be by
16 three-fifths.

17 MRS. FREEDLANDER: Second the motion.

18 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion?

19 DR. BARD: Question.
