question, what about the power to approve bail? If 2 you make it too restrictive, he won't even be able to grant bail. MR. MILLER: It wouldn't in accordance with rule solve any problem. 6 7 MR. SYKES: I think it would. 8 THE CHAIRMAN: I think the discussion that I recall hearing -- and maybe I am thinking of a 9 different place where the discussion was -- was that 10 11 the Commissioners were not intended in any sense to be assistant judges, and they were not to be given 12 the authority to have preliminary hearings, that this 13 was still a judicial function. 14 15 MR. MARTINEAU: That is correct. 16 THE CHAIRMAN: And, therefore, this statement that the Commissioners may issue arrest warrants and 17 determine whether and what amount of bail is required 18 is intended as a complete statement of their jursidiction. 19 I think you could without too much difficulty get a phrase 20 21 that would give them all authority over the issuance or THE JACK SALOMON REPORTING SERVICE
