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MR. CASE: It doesn't say that. It says none of these offices.

THE CHAIRMAN: That is right. That is why I am asking what his amplification meant.

JUDGE ADKINS: The language of this report reads as follows: No Executive Departments or agencies should be constitutionally created. I will be glad to have the reporter elaborate on that.

THE CHAIRMAN: Professor Power.

MR. POWER: I see the inconsistency you are pointing to. My intent in drafting this, and I think it was the Committee's recommendation was, that all of these Executive Departments, agencies, commissions, et cetera, need not be constitutionally created. I suppose we have withdrawn from this recommendation the office of Comptroller and the office of Attorney General, so with this modification, what I intend to do is to say there need be no constitutional mention of the itemized Executive Departments.
