

1 DR. BARD: But a majority of the members.

2 MR. HOFF: In the second sentence did you
3 start that by saying the impeachment power shall extend
4 to --

5 DR. BARD: I haven't finished the first.

6 MR. HOFF: I know, but you don't extend the
7 power to these.

8 DR. BARD: Shall embrace.

9 MR. SYKES: No, they are subject to impeachment.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: I think you have to turn the
11 sentence around.

12 DR. BARD: Subject to the impeachment power.
13 Good point. Shall I finish the second part?

14 THE CHAIRMAN: Yes.

15 DR. BARD: When a majority --

16 THE CHAIRMAN: Who is subject to impeachment.

17 DR. BARD: That is in the second sentence.
18 But a majority of the members must concur. I must say
19 here that there was some difference among our Committee
20 members so that I wish you would pause just a moment to
21 consider it.
