from the judiciary, five named by the legislative branch 1 and five named by the Supreme Court, it seems to me 2 that we would eliminate any problem. It is a novel area. 3 If the Governor is being impeached or tried on impeachment, it seems to me important enough to establish some 5 semblance of procedure in the Constitution. 6 MRS. BOTHE: There is going to be some 7 difficulty in the case of a possible impeachment of a 8 judge if the courts were to remove under the judiciary 9 article and the other under the impeachment provision. 10 11 In the former instance it is the Supreme Court that has the power, and you would be walking into a conflict of 12 the Legislature telling the Supreme Court what to do. 13 DR. BARD: What would you have there? 14 MRS. BOTHE: In the cases of judges being 15 16

MRS. EOTHE: In the cases of judges being impeached, you are going to run into all kinds of difficulty if the Legislature can require the judiciary to sit in judgment with the removal provisions of the judiciary.

MR. MILLER: There is another reason we considered of giving the Legislature some pick of who the
