In the first place, the designation of the five or whatever number of judges by the Legislature is going to be a football and, second, it violates a principle in my mind that the Legislature shouldn't be able to yank judges around and tell them where they are going to sit and for what reason. There will be no coordination and cooperation between the Legislature and the Supreme Court in a case of this sort.

MR. MARTINEAU: I can't think of anything the Legislature is less equipped to do than to pick people to try a particular case. I think the designation of so many judges by the legislative branch would be, as Mrs. Bothe said, pure chaos.

MR. MITCHELL: I think the reason for the compromise is this. The most serious indictment or impeachment which might be tried would be that of the Governor, and the second most serious impeachment I can
