

1 MR. SYKES: It doesn't matter if you have
2 a majority.

3 MR. MILLER: You have to have three-fifths.
4 You have to have six.

5 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Sykes.

6 MR. SYKES: This is a specially constituted
7 tribunal with a final jurisdiction.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: That is right.

9 MR. SYKES: There is no appeal.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: Is there any objection to a
11 ten-judge panel?

12 MR. MARTINEAU: As I said, I think that is
13 too many.

14 THE CHAIRMAN: How many favor a ten-judge
15 panel?

16 MR. BROOKS: Twelve.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: How many favor less than a
18 ten-judge panel?

19 MR. BROOKS: One.

20 THE CHAIRMAN: Ten to one in favor of the
21 ten-judge panel. Is there any dissent from the proposition
