which did not have a convention but had a Constitution voted on Tuesday a week ago, which had been drafted by a Commission, then submitted to the General Assembly, which approved it, referred it to the public for referendum, was defeated by a vote of something like four to one.

The Florida experience, at the moment we have distributed to all of you copies of the Florida Constitution. That one also was one not drafted by a Constitutional Convention. It was not voted on last election Tuesday a week ago but will be submitted sometime in February or March to a special referendum of the public. Indications gleaned from talking with persons at this particular meeting were that there is very little hope that this Constitution will be ratified either. The anticipation is that it will be defeated by at least a two to one vote.

I mentioned previously the experience in Rhode Island. That Convention is still in progress, has been since December, 164. The experience there is that they hope to complete their redraft of a Constitution
