different from what they are doing now. As you know, their convention has been meeting about two years now. I think they meet once a month and debate and discuss but really accomplish practically nothing.

The Chairman of the Convention was present and participated in the discussion in Boston. certainly was anything but optimistic.

New York's experience or lack of experience was also illuminating. They have a preparatory Commission. The Commission has been apparently tied up or tied down with politics and lack of funds for the entire period of its existence. Until very recently it had accomplished nothing at all.

It now has been torn asunder by conflicts between the staff and the Convention, with resignations of the Executive Director, and the whole setup of the Convention as described at the meeting, of the preparatory Commission, is entirely different from anything we have been attempting to do. The Commission is politically oriented with very definite attempts to balance the representation in the Commission among the various
