the Legislative district of the City of Baltimore or the counties. We have not made a specific recommendation on this point but our proposed enabling act will contain it.

I believe the Commission has concluded that a delegate can run from the county. In other words, the delegates would be elected from the county not from the various subLegislative districts you have in election of delegates.

THE CHAIRMAN: The Commission has not taken a position on that.

MR. SCANLAN: I know. So far as qualifications are concerned, except for the clergyman barrier, which we would recommend not apply here, the qualifications would be the same as membership in the House-of Delegates.

THE CHAIRMAN: May I ask a question for clarification before we have discussion in view of your last comment. Did you mean that the Committee is recommending in the case of one running from a Legislative district in the county that he be a resident of
