a very, very important report and will require some discussion. Any other Committee reports which have details to pick up will have to be decided at that time.

MR. MARTINEAU: One of the items we are starting to consider in our Committee is the schedule. I haven't heard any discussion from any of the other Committees as to their proposals to be included in the schedule of when we are going to wind up considering this. I would like information on this.

THE CHARMAN: I would like to try to discuss this somewhat before the day's session is finished because this too will be a matter that we will have to consider at the next and, I hope, final meeting. That's a matter of the schedule to be attached to the Constitution. One of the important things we have to consider in connection with that schedule is the nature of it. We have been talking rather loosely about a schedule which is subject to a change by the Legislature. This will not be possible as to some things that we have been thinking would go into the schedule. It may be that the schedule would be of two
