Committees can be present. I suggest to you that the importance of having a meeting is such that you schedule it even though you can't have full attendance.

MR. BOND: I just polled all members of each subcommittee and we can meet after this adjourns today.

THE CHAIRMAN: You still have to take testimony of the State Treasurer.

All right. If there are no other matters of general announcement, we are ready to move ahead on consideration of the Seventh Report of the Committee on Political Subdivisions and Local Legislation. You should have before you now the Seventh Report of that Committee together with the memorandum headed staff memorandum dated November 21, 1966.
