said he will participate in all further meetings ofthe Commission. Mr. Clagett.

MR. CLAGETT: Mr. Chairman, I would like at the outset to adopt a form of approach and since we haven't had a chance to coordinate in that regard, prior to now, do you want to follow the procedure that we have previously followed, namely reading the entire article, then going back section by section? Or would you prefer that I merely point up areas of change and go on the assumption that the report has been read and the comment digested by the members of the Commission.

THE CHAIRMAN: I think in view of the re-arrangement of the article, it would be better to take a few minutes and read through the entire article, then come back and take it up section by section.

MR. CLAGETT: Very well, sir. Mr. Chairman,
I am reading on Page 1 of the Seventh Report, Article
XI, Section 11.01, Units of Local Government. Subsection
(a). For the purposes of this Constitution, Baltimore
