my dubiety on the decision of many courts, that registration as required of voters is not a qualification for voting, but an administrative addition of demonstrating qualifications. I think this language could be clearer.

DR. BURDETTE:

discussion it seems to me if the minds around this table don't find this proposition evident, the best thing we can do is change the language, because I think it is pretty apparent that everybody wants that limitation and if there is doubt about itself think it is a fairly easy matter to clarify.
