law should provide for vacancies. Certainly the vacancy might occur from the death of a nominee, and I should think myself that we could leave that problem to the Legislature acting by law, but I would like to ask the Committee another question. I have not read until the past half hour this proposal, and it seems to me to originate from the system we have in the National Government, but not on the same foundation. You see, we now have -- we haven't had very long but we now have an arrangement that the candidate for vice president is almost certainly acceptable to the candidate for president. We would have no such arrangement as that here at the present time. It might very well be that one faction of a party would win the Gubernatorial nomination and another faction win the Lieutenant Gubernatorial nomination and therefore they are elected together. What concerns me, aren't we getting into trouble about this being a relative? I don't have the answer.
