and, secondly, that the lending of the credit of the county 1 be authorized by an extraordinary vote of whatever the 2 authorizing body would be. MR. CLAGETT: Is that the General Assembly or the county legislative body? 5 THE CHAIRMAN: Whatever the authorizing body would be. 7 MR. CASE: Whatever the authorizing agency would 8 be. 9 10 MR. CLAGETT: I understand it. 11 THE CHAIRMAN: To get that before us, Mr. Case, would you make a motion and I would suggest that it not be 12 an amendment of any of these existing subsections, but an 15 additional subsection to 11.03. 14 15 MR. CASE: I so move. 16 DR. BARD: Seconded. 17 THE CHAIRMAN: The motion is that an additional subsection be added to 11.03 to provide that the county 18 shall have the power to incur indebtedness only for a public 19 purpose and that it could not lend assets or credit of the 20 county unless a public purpose would be served and the public 21
