7	vote even submitted to referendum.
2	MR. CASE: If a referendum were required by the
3	charter of that particular county.
4	MR. SAYRE: Well, they could either submit it or
5	not submit it, according to the terms of their charter.
6	MR. CASE: Most charters say they have to be sub
7	mitted or, if it doesn't say anything, they are not sub-
8	mitted.
9	MR. SAYRE: Would this also apply to regional
10	governments?
11	MR. CASE: I would hope that it would. I would
12	suggest
13	MR. SAYRE: It would be inconsistent not to
14	apply one place and
15	MR. CASE: Yes. I think this is a very important
16	thing, because the whole is no stronger than the sum of the
17	strength of its parts, and once you start chipping away at
18	the level of the region or the county, then you are really
19	hurting the State. You are hurting everybody.
20	THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Martineau?
21	MR. MARTINEAU: It would seem to me, although
