thought perhaps you might even want to go previous to the third Wednesday in order to give them some time in advance of the Legislature coming in. Did you discuss that at all?

JUDGE ADKINS: We discussed that. We could see no particular reason for that. The main problem would be a budgetary problem, making up the budget but all of the former Governors with whom we discussed the matter have indicated the budget procedure is sufficiently well established now so they are almost in constant contact with the budget bureau from the date of election. There is no real problem. Moreover, some of the Governors expressed the thought that they would like to have the period as much preparatory time prior to actually assuming the office as they could have. The reason for making it concurrent with the Legislature, we felt that this week or so period, with a lame duck Governor and a new Legislature would not be a particularly healthy condition; that there could be potential problems arise out of it.
