11.03(b). Mr. Clagett?

MR. CLAGETT: Here we provide for classification and the classification is based upon population as determined by the most recent U.S. Census or upon other criteria provided by law. We, however, limit the number of classes to five and the number of counties must be at least three in any one class. A classification may be changed, but only one classification may be in effect at any one time.

This, I might add, is similar to the section previously considered by the Commission and approved at
