MRS. BOTHE: I don't see where it does,
Mr. Clagett. Here it is in conflict, I believe, with
11.02(b), because I think what you are contemplating
there is that the Legislature could enact laws which
would withdraw powers from particular counties which are
to be included in a region, but these counties might not
be all in the -- they might be in a classification with
counties where powers would not or should not be withdrawn and the only point of this is that it would enable
the Legislature to take powers away for this one purpose
and not to observe the classification in doing it.

MR. CLAGETT: Referring to that 11.01, subsection (b), where we provide that the General Assembly may provide by law; it doesn't say by general public law. It says, may provide by law for multiple county civil divisions.

MRS. BOTHE: It still doesn't provide that they may take power away from counties, which is provided for in 11.03.

THE CHAIRMAN: May I ask a question for clarification, Mrs. Bothe? As I understand the language you
