are now proposing for 11.02(c), you intend to broaden this power of the General Assembly only to the extent of saying that it could withdraw powers from counties comprising a region, without regard to the classification system?

MRS. BOTHE: Right.

THE CHAIRMAN: In other words, Mr. Clagett, that if the General Assembly, under Section 11.02(b), withdraws from the component counties certain powers and grants them to a region, that it is not subject to the classification requirements of 11.03(c).

To use a specific example, if you had five classes of counties and you created a region of Baltimore City and Baltimore County, which would not be a classification, the Legislature under this amendment could withdraw powers from Baltimore City and Baltimore County and grant them to that region.

MR. CLAGETT: And once it has granted them to that region, then, of course, the region would exercise those powers subject to the same power of withdrawal and you've got the General Assembly dealing in the local
