THE CHAIRMAN: I am more confused than in just a watter of terminology. What I am confused about, in spite of the explanations by Mr. Clagett, is what does the Committee intend that a county of any class shall do within the first four years? Does a county have to take any action? Does Prince George's County have to do anything under the provision of this section?

MR. CLAGETT: No, they don't.

THE CHAIRMAN: Why don't they?

MR. CLAGETT: The answer is they want to live in contentment for four more years.

THE CHAIRMAN: After the four years, does

Prince George's County, under your understanding, have to
do anything?

MR. CLAGETT: No, because by January 1st of the fourth year, a charter drawn by the General Assembly will then be imposed upon Prince George's County and it will have a charter.

THE CHAIRMAN: In other words, you are saying that you want to abolish the County Commissioner method of operating county governments after four years?
