MR. POWER: It is not included simply because it is not finished yet.

DR. BARD: I see. It does belong in Roman Numeral I in this area?

MR. POWER: Yes, in this immediate area.

THE CHAIRMAN: Is it contemplated simply that it be a provision that the Lieutenant Governor would succeed or something more than this?

MR. POWER: As I say, it is not finished.

I suppose the most difficult problem I see here is
to what extent the Lieutenant Governor should be
Governor when the Governor is out of the state. Again
we haven't really resolved that, but that is certainly
