JUDGE ADKINS: The General Assembly shall 1 provide by law --2 THE CHAIRMAN: Public general law. 3 JUDGE ADKINS: All right, shall provide by public general law for an instrument of government which 5 shall become effective for all counties which, on January l of the fourth year following the effective date of this 7 Constitution, and here we insert new language, have not 8 previously adopted the local instrument of government 9 which has been submitted to and approved by a majority 10 vote of its people. 11 THE CHAIRMAN: Is there a second? 12 MR. MITCHELL: Second it. 13 MR. CLAGETT: What happens in the period of 14 four years? 15 JUDGE ADKINS: Exactly what would have happened 16 under your language. 17 MR. CLAGETT: Well, you would still have Sub-18 section (b). 19 JUDGE ADKINS: I don't know. We haven't gotten 20 to that yet. 21
