THE CHAIRMAN: Give me the last part of that --1 not previously adopted a local instrument of government. 2 what? JUDGE ADKINS: Which has been submitted to and approved by a majority vote of its people. I said people, 5 but Dr. Burdette suggested voters. 6 DR. BURDETTE: Qualified voters voting on their 7 own. 8 JUDGE ADKINS: By a vote of the qualified 9 voters voting on their own. 10 MR. SAYRE: If you said instrument of home rule 11 12 government --JUDGE ADKINS: I'm just trying to maintain the 13 language they used in the first sentence, that's all. 14 DR. BURDETTE: I have no objection to home rule 15 MR. SAYRE: Isn't that what we're after? 16 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Bond? 17 MR. BOND: May I ask Judge Adkins, under this 18 proposal, within the four-year period, couldn't just a 19 County Commissioner form of government be presented to 20 the people and be adopted? 21
