MR. CLAGETT: You would have to do it subject 1 to referendum. 2 MR. MARTINEAU: Why? 3 MR. CLAGETT: Well, because we feel that is inherent in the adoption of any charter or instrument of 5 6 government. THE CHAIRMAN: Mrs. Bothe? . 7 MRS. BOTHE: I was wondering whether this 8 language, whether it is yours or Judge Adkins', would 9 adequately guarantee that a county would adopt an instru-10 ment of government adequate to home rule powers, because 11 it seems to me you have a loophole here in which a county 12 that adopted any kind of government could say, we'll have 13 14 a dog catcher --It would be put into effect by MR. CLAGETT: 15 the very persons who are being governed by that government. 16 May I say, what you are saying right now we tried to do. 17 and who is going to determine what is suitable? 18 MR. SAYRE: The people ought to. 19 MR. CLAGETT: They can do that by this method
