in Prince George's County is in the direction of acceptance 1 of the idea. 2 MRS. BOTHE: May I raise a question of a 3 hiatus that might be created if something less than a charter or instrument were created during the four-year 5 period and then the charter provided by the Legislature 6 wouldn't be operative. 7 MR. CLAGETT: Say that again. 8 THE CHAIRMAN: But if it is a less adequate 9 one, it is one that the people of the county have adopted. 10 MRS. BOTHE: Perhaps. 11 THE CHAIRMAN: Not perhaps. They will have. 12 Otherwise, they will not have complied with this section. 13 MR. CASE: She's talking about the four-year 14 period. 15 THE CHAIRMAN: That's right, within the four-16 year period, the people have to adopt it. 17 MR. CASE: Suppose they don't do anything? 18 THE CHAIRMAN: Then the charter adopted by the 19 Legislature becomes effective. 20 MR. CASE: That's right, but at the end of the 21
