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Proposing an amendment.

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JUDGE ADKINS: On that comment you made, I don't think -- it certainly was not intended by my amendment. You said must act within the four-year period. I don't conceive that to the be case. Counties which have heretofore enacted a charter form of government, as, for

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example, my own county of Wicomico, would not have to resubmit that within the four-year period in order to be within the exemption. They must have done it prior to the four-year expiration after the adoption of this Constitution. THE CHAIRMAN: That's correct.

MR. SAYRE: I have a problem which maybe you can clarify, Judge. Are we allowing the counties to have all powers not otherwise delegated? Now, I'm not clear from your language that this Constitutional form of government that is required for all counties that had not taken action prior to January 1, I'm not clear that the General Assembly incorporates all the powers necessary to have those reserve powers.
