the General Assembly to come up with an instrument of 1 government that grants all of the powers necessary to 2 home rule? Maybe I'm confused. Doesn't home rule mean you have all powers not otherwise denied? MR. CLAGETT: Except by the charter and by the 5 General Assembly by general public law or by the Constitu-6 7 tion. MR. SAYRE: If you deny powers in your charter 8 no one else is excrcising, where are you? 9 MR. CLAGETT: You better go ahead and amend it 10 under Subsection (c), and go ahead and get it. 11 THE CHAIRMAN: May I assume the prerogative 12 of a Chairman and at the moment the provider of things to 13 eat and say we have to adjourn if we are not going to have 14 to make new arrangements to take the place of other new 15 arrangements. 16 (At this point there was a dinner recess.) 17 18 19 20
